Finance:

i have been informing you by about the fact that the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI} did not have any revenue until year 2022. In fact, for simple reason of solidarity with its members and in order to assist the members to face their financial obligation through HSFI and also in their own State Associations, the Board of Directors of the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI} was agreed that for time being the members will be exempted from paying their annual membership affiliation to the National Federation.

However, since the decision of the Board of Directors of 27 March 2022 the affiliation annual fees is decreased and implemented starting January 2023, in conformity of the provisions of statutes of the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI}.

The only revenue of the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI} was the amount of entry fee during the biannual National Championships received for registration of athletes which is served by organizing committee for payment of related costs of the same championships. This is of course non-significant amount compares to the cost of administration and workloads of the HSFI National Federation and of course important cost of organization of the National Championships.

We have confirmed that the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI} dose not receive any subsidy from Govt. of India-Ministry of Sports Department in 2022 year.

All activities of the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI}, including the costs of its day- to-day administration since its inception in 2022, have been funded from the personal funds of Mr. Pradeep Shinde, President of the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI}.

We have made available to our members the audited financial statement for years ended 31 December 2022, the budget for year 2023.

Unfortunately despite the existence of the annual membership fee, as explained above, it has never been implemented before January 2023, in order to help the member to meet their other financial obligations. Indeed, the annual contribution has only been in place since January 2023 after having been reduced by decision of the Board of Directors on 27 March, 2022.

These annual membership fees do not bring significant revenue to the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI} and, among other things, many members have defaulted on their financial obligations to the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI}. As a simple example, a total of 700 US\$ were received as annual memberships for the years 2023 respectively.

Like previous years, we did not have any income in 2022. The working expenses and operating expenses for year 2022 amount totaled 2380 US\$ which were advanced by the personal funds of the chairman. For the first time, the income for annual affiliation memberships fee during 2023 of 700 US\$ allowed the loss to decrease to 1680 US\$ for the years 2023 respectively

The loss for the years 2022 were advanced by personal funds of President and is added to the previous year's President Advance/Loan as loss brought forward.















The Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI}'s working expenses and operating expenses compared to the important activities during these years are reasonable. However, the Asian Confederation is now looking actively for the sponsors to finance its operations and increase its activities.

It should be noted that the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI} had important activities during the last years such as the World Championships Dual Rules in October 2021 in Moscow, Russia, the World Hand-to-hand fighting sport Championships in April 2022 in Bukhara, Uzbekistan, the Asian Hand-to-hand fighting sport Championships in November 2022 in Kazan, Russia including participation.

During 2022, we had important costs in particular due to legal works for revision of statutes of National federation requested by HSIF. Also, preparation of our General Assembly in March 2022 which organisation was granted by mandate to the accredited law firm as decided by the decision of the Board of Directors of the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI}.

The above-mentioned costs are largely superior to what are the total income of annual membership's affiliation fee.

It is obvious that non-significant amount of the annual membership affiliation fee which is in place only from 2023 is not allow the National federation to assure its operations properly.

Therefore, it is necessary to find additional income for the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India {HSFI} to assure the working and operating expenses which are important due to our activities and our mission to develop Hand To Hand Fighting Sport in India. We are also seeking for the sponsor and welcome any proposal assistance.

Conclusions

As you can see, we have undertaken to the best of our abilities all the necessary actions to ensure the continuity of our activities in the interest of all our members. We have made sure to be present and continue to do so and have organized the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport competitions expected in 2022.

We update the information very often and keep all members and community in case there is any pertinent change in the announced program which should be considerate as provisional.

This report is published without prejudice and may be revised and supplemented should any omission or error be brought to our attention.

I would like to thank all members for their active participation in our activities in 2022 and in particular our prestigious National Championships which took place with great success from 10 to 11 September, 2022 with the participation of 14 Indian State from 5 different Zone of India















I would also like to thank the various committees of the Hand To Hand Fighting Sport Federation of India (HSIF India) and their members for their efforts and contributions who continue to work as volunteers in difficult conditions and bring us their skills for a better organization and promotion of our sport.
